Assessment Outcomes for 2019-2020
Master of Divinity

Outcome 1: Graduates will possess knowledge of the official teaching of the Roman Catholic Church and ability to articulate it.

Outcome 2: Graduates will be able to draw on the broad spectrum of the Catholic theological tradition in pastoral analysis and practice, including preaching.

Outcome 3: Development of the professional skills, attitudes, and dispositions necessary for service as an ordained priest.

Catechetical Practicum Evaluation (<i>Theology II</i>)	Students will receive an average score of 6 or higher on all measures.	95% passed benchmark (n=21); 1 student scored < 6 on one measure
Pastoral Internship Evaluation (<i>Internship Year</i>)	Students will receive an average score of 6 or higher on all measures.	88% passed benchmark (n=8); 1 student scored < 6 on three measures
Survey of Supervising Pastors	Supervisors will, on average, report a score of 6 or higher.	No data (<i>COVID-19</i>)
Survey of MDiv Graduates	Graduates will, on average, report a score of 6 or higher.	8.6 (n=12)

Retention Rate (4-year) 73% (n=52)
